The Science in Action program provides a **free** one period session of demos and experiments in Science, for grades K through 12 in our schools. Our Presenter brings in the vacuum apparatus, to conduct the program in the individual teacher's classroom. In our first school year of providing this program in 2008/2009, we have worked with over 3800 students in the San Francisco Bay Area.

Our intention is to pique the interest of the students in Science, and demystify some of the words of Science, such as atmospheric pressure, vaporization, gas expansion, etc.
